Rules – Please read carefully. Placing an entry is deemed as acceptance of these rules.

The judges' decision is final in all matters and includes the right to eliminate.

Age assumed as of 1st January in the current year.

All persons riding horses or ponies at the Unicorn Centre MUST wear a hat with chinstrap fastened conforming to PAS 015 or European Standard BSEN 1384 at all times when mounted. From 1 January 2017 only hats carrying the PAS 015 standard will be permitted.

All horses and ponies must be four years old or older & no stallions to be entered.

All competitors and spectators enter the Unicorn Centre premises at their own risk and no liability can be accepted by the RDA Centre in Cleveland Ltd for any injury, loss or damage. The organisers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and in addition obeying instructions of the organiser, officials and stewards and as displayed on notices.

In the interests of safety, numbers of horses & ponies warming up in the outdoor school will be strictly limited to a maximum number of 8 at any one time. Lunging is not allowed. Riding on the grass around the outdoor school area is also prohibited. Only riders competing in the show are allowed to warm up in the outdoor arena.

Entries will not be accepted without payment, including telephone entries. All entry fees are non-refundable. Competitors are advised that entry fees will not be refunded in the event of classes running later than expected. Dressage rosettes/prizes will be presented after all dressage classes have concluded. Rosettes/ prizes will be kept for collection for 1 week after show date or can be posted out on receipt of an SAE.

Please take your litter home with you or deposit it in the bins provided.

No loose dogs and no dogs in the viewing gallery inside the centre.
