Entries will not be accepted without payment, including telephone entries. All entry fees are non-refundable. Competitors are advised that entry fees will not be refunded in the event of classes running later than expected. Dressage rosettes/prizes will be presented after all dressage classes have concluded. Show jumping rosettes/prizes will be presented after all show jumping classes have concluded. Rosettes/prizes will be kept for collection for 1 week after show date or can be posted out on receipt of an SAE.

The Judge's decision is FINAL in all matters & includes the right to eliminate.

Ages as of 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year.

ALL people riding horse/ponies at the Unicorn Centre MUST wear a hat with chinstrap fastened conforming to PAS015 (1998 or 2011) with BSI Kitemark, ASTM F1163 with SEI Kitemark, SNELL E2001 or VG1 at all times when mounted.

All Horses/ponies must be 5 years old or older and no stallions to be entered in any class.

The Unicorn Centre reserves the right to amend the schedule as deemed necessary

ALL competitors/spectators enter the premises at their own risk and no liability can be accepted by the RDA Centre in Cleveland Ltd. for any injury, accident, loss or damage.

The organisers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present.
